
Nexus App for Medikin Online 3.0

- Nexus is an application that resides on the PC of the doctor, Medical Records Manager (MRM) or Transcriber (MT or QA)
- Nexus automatically uploads new audio files when a digital recorder is docked to the PC and automatically downloads finished reports for the doctor and MRM. MTs also use Nexus to automatically download new audio files
- Clients have always loved the simplicity and automation of our upload/download app. Nexus, the Medikin 3.0 version, has these added benefits:





Nexus is more user-friendly for doctors, which means less support for you

- Nexus works even when the user is not logged in to Medikin Online via the browser
- → Nexus shows the progress of each individual file as it is uploading or downloading
- → Nexus nomenclature is more clear. Upload is called Send. Download is called Get
- → Nexus has a refresh button. You'll never have to explain how to refresh via rightclicking
- → Nexus has buttons linking directly to the storage folders of files on the client's PC
- → Nexus has a more modern and professional look and feel

Nexus is secure and robust

- → Nexus requires its own encrypted login
- → Nexus contains a thorough transaction log which can be used to diagnose errors

Adding the *Nexus* app is easy

- Upon activation the client sees a prominently displayed *Download Nexus* button
- → The doctor or MRM can just click on the Download Nexus button and follow the simple installation instructions
- → The user can run Nexus by clicking on its icon or Start / All Programs / Nexus
- → The doctor or MRM can log in using the same credentials as if logging into Medikin Online
